Your student is eligible to participate in W.I.N (What I Need) classes at Kreiva Academy to receive additional math support outside of their regular math course. W.I.N. courses are made possible through Title I funding and student eligibility is based on standardized assessment results and/or academic progress in courses. For some students who have missed more than 10 days of school in a given year, attendance also can play a role in eligibility. NWEA assessment results will be emailed to all W.I.N. families during the week of March 6th as Kreiva students are currently in the process of completing the mid-year assessment. It is our sincere hope that additional support provided through W.I.N. courses will further help students to meet grade-level proficiency in mathematics.

An informational meeting to provide an overview of mathematics Title I support provided in W.I.N classes will be held the evening of the Trimester 2 Exhibition night on Tuesday, March 7th. The meeting will take place at 5:00pm - 5:30pm in room 210. For any families that can not attend this meeting, the presentation will be emailed to all families of W.I.N students.
